

2016 Dairyland Conference Track and Field Meet Blair-Taylor High School

Site: Blair-Taylor Schools

Schools: Alma/Pepin, Augusta, Blair-Taylor, Cochrane-Fountain City, Eleva-Strum, Immanuel Lutheran, Independence-Gilmanton, Lincoln, Melrose-Mindoro and Whitehall.

Facility: Track: 8 lanes straightaway, all weather surfaces. Long, Triple, High Jump and Pole Vault are all weather surfaces. Shot and Discus are concrete.

Entries: Entries will be done on (www.pttiming.com).

Individual entries:

Maximum of 28 individual entries with no more than 3 per event.

Relay entries:

One relay team per school.

You may list up to 6 individuals per relay event.

(Listing an athlete on a relay counts as one of their 4 events.)

Entries will be open on May 7th and will close at noon on Tuesday, May 12th.

(Reminder that PTTiming will assess a fee for late entries.)

Rules: WIAA format (4 event max, no more than 3 running or field)

- Awards:** All-Conference certificates will be awarded to the top three place winners in each individual and relay event. The winner of each event will be 1st team all-conference, 2nd place will be 2nd place all-conference and 3rd place will be honorable mention all-conference. We will start awarding certificates during the 3200 meter run. There will be an awards area on the infield in front of the grandstand.
- Equipment:** Blocks will be provided. Be sure your athletes use spikes no longer than $\frac{1}{4}$ inch. You must bring your own batons. Runway and exchange zone marks should be made with chalk.
- Lanes:** Lane 4 will be seeded with the fastest time with lanes 5-3-6-2-7-1-8 with the next fast times.
- Concessions:** Concessions will be provided by the Blair-Taylor Track Boosters.
- Admission:** Admission will be charged at this conference event. (Established by the conference)
- Adults - \$5 Students - \$3
- Implements:** Implements will be weighed under the grandstand.
- Throws:** Each competitor will get three throws with the top 9 throwers given three additional throws in the finals.
- Jumps:** Each jumper will get three jumps in the preliminaries to be taken between 4:15 and 6:15 in cafeteria style. Finals will start at 6:30 with the jumps taking place in reverse order of the preliminary finish. Moving to the finals will be the top 9 jumpers in each event.

Running Prelims: Moving to the finals will be heat winners plus the next fastest times until all lanes are filled.
