FIELD EVENT ORDERS: Girls High Jump, Long Jump and Shot Put, followed by boys  
Boys Pole Vault, Discus, Triple Jump, followed by girls

ENTRIES: **36 Individual Entries** Maximum  
No more than three entries in each individual event may enter  
One relay team entry in each relay event  
WIAA rules determine which events an individual may enter  
**Entries must be entered on [pttiming.com](http://pttiming.com)\* by 11:59 a.m., Tuesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>**

Teams not entering lineups on [pttiming.com](http://pttiming.com) by deadline will incur a \$50 late fee charge.

SCRATCHES/ CHANGES: Please make all scratches/changes in the press box as soon as you arrive  
Deadline for ALL changes is 3:00 p.m.

SCORING: Eight place scoring for all events (10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1)

TIMING: Fully Automatic Timing (PT Timing)

AWARDS: Medals will be awarded for the first 8 individuals and 5 relay places  
Awards and meet results may be picked up in the press box at the conclusion of the meet  
Results will also be posted at [pttiming.com](http://pttiming.com)

## RUNNING EVENTS

All lanes are assigned by seed times.

100, 200, 400, 400 Relay, 800 Relay, High Hurdles, and 300 Hurdles are → 8, 6, 4, 2, 1, 3, 5, 7  
800, 1600, 3200, 1600 Relay, and 3200 Relay are → 1, 2, 3, 4..

Trials: 100, 200, High Hurdles (unless 8 or less total athletes)

Qualifier: Heat winners qualify plus the next fastest competitors to fill 8 lanes

Timed finals: In all timed finals the fastest section will be last

## FIELD EVENT

Pole Vault/High Jump

Competitors compete in order of submitted heights, lowest to highest  
Five alive will be used

Long Jump/Triple Jump

Open pit trials for ninety minutes followed by fifteen-minute break and finals to completion (Top 8)

Shot Put Discus

Three flights – Compete in order of shortest to longest

Finals will follow trials to completion (Top 8)

NOTE: Follow WIAA tournament sequencing of attempts for throws

- FACILITIES:** All running and jumping areas have an all-weather surface.  
The shot and discus areas will be held in the field across from Jacobson Field
- RESTRICTED AREAS:** The infield area is off limits to athletes & coaches → all warm ups should occur outside the track area once the meet has begun (exception – during the break) – warm up area is behind the away stands along the river.  
The press box is off limits to everyone except coaching staff & meet officials  
The finish area is off limits to everyone except meet officials  
Coaching boxes will be marked at all field events
- NO LOCKER ROOMS:** No school facilities will be available. Please secure your own clothes and valuables as we cannot be responsible for loss or theft.
- EQUIPMENT:** Please remind your runners that spikes may not be longer the 1/4”  
Starting blocks will be the only equipment provided  
Shot and discus will be checked at the garage prior to the meet  
Hip numbers can be obtained at the north end of the track (tent)
- TRAINER:** An athletic trainer will be available for athletes during the meet at the south end of track.
- CONCESSIONS:** Concessions will be available for athletes and spectators  
There will be a meal for coaches and workers served in the shed near the track entrance
- T-SHIRTS SALES:** Big Eight Conference Meet shirts will be available under the stands
- ADMISSION:** \$5.00 – All spectators
- WEATHER:** If inclement weather occurs the meet announcer will clear the stadium and instruct all athletes and spectators to enter the school and eventually into the field house  
No one will be allowed to stay under the stadium
- BUS PARKING:** Buses will arrive from the North to drop off athletes. Parking is located in the lot across from Burger King.
- TEAM CAMP:** There is be a team camp designated area across the street from Jacobson Field.

### WHEELCHAIR COMPETITION:

In the event of a wheelchair competition, the schedule will be as follows:

100 m (after the boys 100m dash trials)  
1600m (after the boys 200m dash trials)  
400m (after the boys 400m dash)  
800m (after the boys 800m dash)  
Shot Put will be at 2:30

All wheelchair events will be completed as coed finals (results will be separated for boys/girls)

\* If there are 18 or fewer competitors, there will be only 1 section

\*\* Number of heats will be determined by number of lanes and number of entries

\*\*\* 4x800 Relay, 1 heat, waterfall start

\*\*\*\* If there are 24 or fewer entrants 2 sections will be run  
If there are 25 or more entrants 3 sections will be run
