DIRECTIONS TO THREE LAKES SKI TRAIL:

Coming off Highway 53, take exit number 110, which is the Highway 40 exit, into Bloomer. When you reach the bridge just past the high school, take a right onto Main Street. Travel two (2) blocks and turn left onto 18th Avenue. When you reach the stop sign, turn right onto Martin Rd. This is also County Highway SS. Stay on SS until you reach 110th Street. Turn right onto 110th street and then take a left onto 165th Avenue. The Three Lakes Ski Trail will be on the right just after you go over the first hill. **Bus Parking will be available in the field. Spectator parking on the road (165th Avenue).**
