Location: Football Field where teams can socially distance

ONLINE ENTRY REQUIRED: This event is being timed by PT Timing. *Entries are required to be entered online at <https://wi.milesplit.com/meets/399230/registration> no later than Wednesday, October 14th at NOON.* Late entries will be charged \$50. You do NOT need to designate if your runners are Varsity or JV.

Coaches Packet Pick-Up: Coaches can pick up team packets starting at 9:30am at the finish line. The packet will include your list of the runners, maps, and your Timing Chips and Bibs.

Course: See attached map for the course. The Course is marked with a solid two white boundary lines.

Parking: Busses can drop off the runners in the north parking lot by the starting line but need to park in the main parking lot. No parking will be allowed in the north lot by the starting line.

Scoring & Awards: The conference CC meet will be scored by counting the first 5 runners for each team that come across the finish line. The next two runners will be the push (Tie Breaker) runners. Teams do not have to designate their varsity runners. The top ten male and female varsity runners will be awarded medals and will be designated All-Conference.

Tent Areas: No Team Tents Permitted

Athletes Only Finish Area: A fenced area past the finish line will have water in it for the racers. ONLY Athletes are allowed in this area. Once they exit the post- race area they will not be allowed back in.

Timing: The event will be chip timed by PT Timing. Results will be posted at www.pttiming.com

Uniforms: Please be aware that this is a championship meet and the last meet before WIAA sectionals so the WIAA uniform rules will be in effect. Please make sure that your athletes adhere to the undergarment colors, logos, accessories, jewelry, and rolling of shorts rules for uniforms. If you need a uniform waiver you must request that from Stephanie Hauser at the WIAA Offices. The Meet Official and referee will be enforcing these rules.

Jury of Appeals: The Jury of Appeals will consist of the head coach from Heritage Christian, LCL, and Kenosha Christian Life along with the meet manager and head official.

Concessions will NOT be Available.

Bathrooms: There are Port-A-Johns next to the bleachers and bathrooms are also available inside the school in the Great Hall lobby by the gym.

Spikes in the Building: Please help us to take care of our facilities. NO SPIKES OF ANY KIND IN THE BUILDING AT ANY TIME.

COVID Guidelines

- *Per WIAA guidelines and the governor's mandate, masks must be worn upon arrival to the meet venue and until the warm-ups have started. Face coverings are strong recommended in all settings where people may come in contact with others, including outdoors when maintain physical distance is not possible.*
- Athletes should wear masks up to the start of the race.
- Spectators should wear masks at all times when social distancing is not possible.
- Avoid clumping at the starting line until 5 minutes before your race start.
- When finished, racers should exit as quickly as possible to avoid large groups at the finish
- Due to the size of the event, we ask schools to limit the number of spectators per athlete to 4.
- Spectators are expected to be respectful and follow standard social distancing guidelines.
- Team tents are not permitted.
- Athletes are expected to provide their own water/Gatorade.
- The Awards Ceremony should be modified to facilitate distancing.
