RESTRICTED AREA

- Spectators are asked to stay on the parking lot side of the split-rail fence near the starting line and finish line; spectators may not enter the area near the starting line, the finish line, or the timing company van – this area is reserved for coaches, runners, and meet personnel

PARKING

- Buses will park at the end of the entrance in the parking lot; an attendant will be on site to direct your bus; we ask that vans pull as far to the end of the lot as possible

JURY OF APPEALS

- The jury of appeals for the boys will consist of Allen Knurr (WIAA contracted starter), Mike Daniels (meet manager), and the following three head coaches: Grafton, Hartford, & Menomonee Falls
- The jury of appeals for the girls will consist of Allen Knurr (WIAA contracted starter), Mike Daniels (meet manager), and the following three head coaches: Arrowhead, Germantown, Mukwonago

OFFICIALS

- Tom Johnson - Meet Referee & Allen Knurr - Starter

FEES

- \$25 team fee for qualifying teams
- Schools with incomplete teams pay \$5 per individual
- There is no county park admission fee on Saturday

MEET ENTRIES

- There are no meet entries for the sectional race; only athletes who have advanced out of sub-sectionals will be involved in the sectional competition
- A school may make changes to its tournament roster up until race time
- A school may change its roster from sub-sectionals to sectionals and sectionals to state

TIMING COMPANY

- PrimeTime Timing will be performing the timing services for the WIAA Slinger Cross Country Sectional
- Coaches should pick up meet information and bibs at the finish line in the PrimeTime Timing van
