Entries

Entries are unlimited. An individual may enter in a maximum of four (4) events but no more than three (3) running events or three (3) field events.

Entries Close: 12:00 pm (noon) - Tuesday, April 29, 2025

BE SURE TO CHECK OVER ALL ENTRIES BEFORE THE DEADLINE, AS WE WILL NOT MAKE ADDITIONS ON THE DAY OF THE MEET – SCRATCHES ONLY AFTER THE ENTRY DEADLINE.

There will be 4 throws allowed in the shot put and discus events. There will be 4 jumps allowed in the long jump and triple jump events. There will be no trials/finals in any running or field event. Running events will be seeded slow to fast in the heats.

Facilities

The track is a 400 meter all-weather surface with nine (9) lanes. ¼ inch pyramid spikes are permitted for all events.

The infield area will be closed off to all spectators and athletes not competing in an upcoming event.
