PARK INFORMATION

The Waukesha County Park System charges the
following rates to enter the park:

\$28 for School Buses

\$7 for each car - Annual Park Stickers are
honored

Pass on the following parking payment information to parents/attendees:

- Park permit fees will not be collected when
entering the park.
- All vehicle license numbers will be recorded
while entering and leaving the park.

How to pay - Follow the instructions to pay
online. Create an account and select and pay
your fee. All payments should be made within 5
days of the event to avoid a violation.

Bus payment - You will need to record the license
number of your bus and follow the instructions
for payment.

Parking: Only Meet Workers AND OFFICIALS will
be allowed in the front parking lot. All attendees
must park in designated parking areas.

Waukesha County Parks have a no-firearm policy.
Concealed weapons are NOT allowed. They asked
that this info is shared with all teams and
spectators.

The WIAA discourages dogs and pets at the
competition. Waukesha County Parks have a strict
policy that requires all dogs to be on a leash.

COURSE INFORMATION

The start/finish/team camp area in picnic area #3 is closed and unusable. We are running an alternate course which will start and finish at the front of the park near the beach/pond. The course utilizes the outer loop of our regular course. The course is rolling with grass, dirt, and wood chip surfaces. Spikes can be worn. The course will be lined, coned, and flagged. It is over 3 miles but short of 5000m.
