REMINDERS

- Remind spectators and runners to be conscientious of our neighbors on the golf course and the golf course itself.
 - ***Please stay out of private yards and do not use yards to enter or exit the golf course.***
 - **Please enter/exit through the golf course parking lot or through the entrance/exit by the cannon off of Hoxie Street.**
 - **Please stay off greens and tee boxes.**
- Absolutely NO unloading, loading, or parking on Highway 23. Doing so could result in a ticket being issued.
- Absolutely NO dogs - per WIAA Rules/Regulations and River Valley School Board Policy.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

We will be using Prime Time Timing (PTTiming). Each high school team is allowed to enter seven (7) varsity runners and an unlimited number of JV runners. All participating junior high/middle school teams will be allowed to enter an unlimited number of runners.

In order to register runners, go to www.pttiming.com. From the main page, click on the upcoming events tab, locate the River Valley Invite, and enter your runners into the appropriate races (e.g., varsity, JV, large school, small school, middle school, etc...) by gender.

Please let us know immediately if your district will be bringing a Junior High/Middle School team that is not included in the list of teams. Also, you must ensure that the Junior High/Middle School runners are registered online in the same manner as high school runners. See the online registration section below.

Online registration will close at 12:00 noon on Thursday, September 11th.

Runners entered into the wrong race by their coaches will be removed from scoring and will not be added to or placed into appropriate races for competition, scoring, or award purposes. Please check your team at the time of registration to make sure that runners are entered into the correct race(s).

Teams that do not pre-register online will not be allowed to participate on the day of the race and will not be refunded their entry fees.

INVITE INFORMATION

LOCATION: The race is held at the Spring Green Municipal Golf Course. The golf course entrance is located at the intersection of Hoxie Street and Winsted Street (Hwy 23). The starting line is directly south of the golf course entrance.

PARKING: There is no parking at the Spring Green Municipal Golf Course. The small parking lot that does exist will be used for emergency vehicles, meet staff, and portable toilets. Team buses and spectator vehicles are encouraged to park in the neighborhoods adjacent to the golf course. There should be no parking on Winsted Street (Hwy 23) south of Hoxie Street along the Golf Course. Parking on Hwy 23 may result in your vehicle being ticketed.

RESTROOMS: Portable toilets will be available in the parking lot of the Spring Green Municipal Golf Course. The screened clubhouse will not be available to runners or spectators on the day of the meet.

PACKET AND TIMING INFORMATION PICK-UP: Coaches can pick up their team packets beginning at 7:00 am on race day. The packets and timing information will be available at the starter shed between the Hole 1 Tee Box and the Hole 9 green. Lane assignments and updated course maps will be included in the packet.

COACHES MEETING: A brief coaches meeting will take place at 8:00 am in front of the starter shed.

CONCESSIONS: The River Valley Athletic Booster Club will be selling concession items. We have breakfast (donuts, bagels, coffee, and more) along with lunch (brats, hot dogs, chips, and more) items. We will have a large selection of other food and a variety of beverages.

T-SHIRTS: The River Valley Cross Country Team will be selling t-shirts near the concession stand - \$20 each.

COURSE MAPS: Course maps will be in your race packet on race day. Extra maps will be available at the golf course starter's shed near the race starting line.

- This award should go to an individual who may have had to overcome obstacles in life or running. Please nominate a runner from your girl's team or boy's team (or both) that exhibits the spirit of the race. If more than one nomination is received, the winner will be selected by River Valley School District senior (grade 12) members of the cross country team.
