We are limited entries in the following manner

- Students can be in 4 events- Cannot be all field or all running, but any combination thereof.
- 4 entries for running, 4 for field and one relay per team
- Weigh ins for Shot and Disc in the Press Box from 3:15-3:45PM
- **Pole Vault Verification forms must be updated (May 4th) and can be turned into the event judge**
- **WE WILL BE DOING TRIALS AND FINALS**

Team Camps/Tent City:

Teams should set up camp behind the main bleachers on the North side of the track. There should be ample room for all teams involved to set up . This area will be the closest to the Clerk of Course.

Student Drop Off/Parking:

Teams and buses can drop off at the gate by the bus garage or at the main gate located at the southwest end of the complex. The bus garage will be closer for those that are bringing tents to get to tent city. See attached map. Buses should park up the hill behind the tennis courts. See attached map.

Field Events:

Girls Long Jump followed by Boys

Girls High Jump followed by Boys

Boys Triple followed by Girls

Boys Pole Vault followed by Girls

Girls Shot followed by Boys

Boys Discus followed by Girls

Note: Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot and Discus competitors will be given 3 attempts. Then the top 9 will be called and they will get to warm up and throw/jump an additional 3 times in reverse order
