- COACHES' MEETING AT 3:00PM
- FIELD EVENTS START AT 3:30PM
- RUNNING EVENTS START AT 4:00PM

TIMING SERVICES AND ENTRIES:

- PT Timing will seed the meet and post entry lists and results on line as soon as possible.
- Online entries must be completed 2 days prior to the event. This date is Tuesday, May 4 at 11:59am CST.
- Coaches should register their athletes by visiting www.pttiming.com. To find your event, hover over *Schedule* and click on *All Upcoming Events*.
 - If coaches miss the deadline, the coach should email logan@pttiming.com to reopen the meet. The host school and/or violating school may incur a \$50 late entry fee – PT Timing will make that decision, depending on the situation.
- Each team will be allowed the following entries per event:
 - No more than 3 individuals per team for any individual event
 - No more than 28 individual entries per team
 - One team per relay event
 - Changes at Coaches' Meeting take precedence with approval of Meet Manager.
- Scoring will consist of '8' places.
- Please send entry fee of \$150 to Seymour High School as soon as possible.

AWARDS:

- Team trophies will be presented to the winners of the girls' and boys' teams immediately after the meet.
- Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each event.
- Individual award envelopes must be picked up immediately after the meet from the press box.

COACHES' MEETING:

- A brief coaches' meeting will be held at 3:00pm in the garage bay behind concessions for the purpose of changes in running events.
- A PARTICIPANT MAY BE REPLACED, BUT A PARTICIPANT MAY NOT BE DROPPED FROM ONE EVENT TO BE PUT INTO ANOTHER EVENT.
- Starting heights will be determined upon checking entry forms for the high jump and pole vault.
- THE 10 MINUTE CHECKOUT RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

FIELD EVENT ORDER:

- Girls' Shot Put – will be conducted in flights with time limits with 9 participants to final, then boys
- Boys' Discus – will be conducted in flights with time limits with 9 participants to final, then girls
- Girls' High Jump, then boys – starting heights determined at coaches' mtg
- Boys' Pole Vault, then girls – starting heights determined at coaches' mtg
- Long and Triple Jumps will be open pit for trials
- Girls' Long Jump – 9 participants to final, then boys – one of 2 runways
- Boys' Triple Jump – 9 participants to final, then girls – one of 2 runways

FACILITIES:

- Track is a sealflex surface, 3/16" spikes may be used.
- **Tent city** limited to:
 - Just west of the stadium on opposite side of the fence.
 - Outside of fence nearest the long/triple jump pits.
- Warm-up areas:
 - West of the stadium on opposite side of the fence
 - Immediately north of the track
- Bathrooms and concessions are on site just south of stadium seating.
- Bullpen is at the north end of the track near the start of the 100.
- No locker rooms are available. Come dressed.
- No Frisbees, footballs, radio, etc. are allowed at this meet.
- INFIELD MUST BE CLEARED OF ATHLETES DURING THE MEET

COVID PROTOCOLS:

- Coaches should wear masks at all times.
- Athletes should wear masks prior to warm-ups and when not competing.
- Athletes should bring their own water bottles.
- Athletes/teams should bring their own chalk.
- Athletes/teams should bring their own sanitation.
- Tents are allowed only in inclement weather.
- Athletes are encouraged to leave events with their parents, if they are in attendance, after the completion of their events.
- Athletes/teams should bring their own chalk.
